**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER,  
COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,  
DECLARING A WATER EMERGENCY AND INVOKING  
MEASURES FOR THE CONSERVATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of South River operates a Water Treatment Plant to provide water services to the residents of the Borough of South River; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that various elements of the Borough Water Treatment Plant are in need of replacement and improvement such that an emergency exists; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 333-37, the Borough of South River has the authority to formally declare an emergency exists requiring such measures to be taken for the conservation of water for domestic and sanitary purposes and fire protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Utility Engineer has recommended that the Borough declare an emergency so to aid in the necessary work on the treatment plant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South River desire to declare a water emergency and to invoke water restrictions to aid in the repair of the water treatment plant; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the Borough of South River as follows:

1. The Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Borough Council, proclaims that an emergency exists in the Borough justifying restrictions on water usage throughout the Borough.
2. That the Mayor proclaims the emergency is of the character requiring the restricted use of water as set forth in Proclamation A of South River Borough Code § 333-38.
3. Pursuant to Proclamation A, Borough residents with odd number streets addresses may only sprinkle of lawns, shrubbery and gardens, wash cars, and fill pools on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday between the hours of 6:00am and 9:00am or between 5:00pm and 8:00pm.
4. Pursuant to Proclamation A, Borough residents with even number streets addresses may only use water to sprinkle of lawns, shrubbery and gardens, wash cars, and fill pools on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday between the hours of 6:00 am and 9:00 am or between 5:00pm and 8:00pm.

5. The use of water for the sprinkling of lawns, shrubbery, and gardens, washing of cars and filling of pools shall be prohibited at all other times.
6. That the resolution is effective immediately.
7. That the resolution shall remain in effect until such time as the emergency is declared terminated.
8. That a copy of this resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Borough of South River and posted on the Borough website.
9. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Borough Administrator, Chief of Police, Chief Financial Officer, and all Borough Department Heads.
