

**TO ALL RESIDENTS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER,
NEW JERSEY AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT
OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested by Chapter 251 of the laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App. A: 9-30 et seq; N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 (6); whichever law or laws apply, on March 17, 2020 the Emergency Management Coordinator, in conjunction with the Mayor, declared a State of Emergency exists within the Borough due to the spread of COVID-19 viral outbreak; and

WHEREAS, the State of Emergency was intended to contain the spread of COVID-19 as the number of cases in the State continues to grow; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rule and regulations as are necessary to meet the various problems which have or may occur due to such an emergency, and

WHEREAS, additional regulations are necessary to ensure the continued provision of essential services to Borough residents during this emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Arthur Londensky, Emergency Management Coordinator, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT that the following regulations shall be in addition to all other laws of the State of New Jersey and the Borough of South River:

1. All of the restrictions contained in the March 17, 2020 Declaration and March 19, 2020 Order issued in an effort to combat the COVID-19 virus are hereby incorporated herein by reference and shall continue in full force and effect except as specifically modified by the provisions of the within Order.
2. All public parks and playgrounds shall be closed to the public.
3. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until such time as it is determined by me that an emergency no longer exists.
