


Senior Household "Fix It" Program



The Office on Aging is pleased to announce a new program designed to address minor household services & repairs. Eligible participants include borough Office on Aging members age 60+ without an available &/or capable family member or caregiver who can perform the necessary tasks on their behalf.

Types of services include (but are not limited to):

Replacing &/or installing door locks &/or devices which deter crime, weatherization improvements, changing screens & storm doors, minor plumbing & electrical work, installing grab bars &/or tub rails, & other minor necessary home services & repairs.


Types of services exclude (but are not limited to):

Installation, repair or disposal of major appliances, roofing, aesthetic improvements, lawn mowing, landscaping, leaf raking, snow shoveling, & any service that requires a permit, variance or inspection by a government agency or official.

Requests will be accommodated on a 1st come, 1st served basis, according to level of importance. Emergencies & extreme cases involving safety or health hazards extend beyond the scope of the program.

The "Fix It" program is strictly voluntary, & is available to South River Office on Aging members age 60+, free of charge, through grant funding provided by the Middlesex County Office of Aging & Disabled Services.
