The Planning Board of the Borough of South River will continue the public hearing **on February 16, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of the South River Middle School, located at 3 Montgomery Street, South River, NJ,** to determine if the “Main Street Rehabilitation District Study Area” as delineated in South River Borough Council Resolution #2015-347 satisfies the statutory requirements listed in the Local Housing and Redevelopment Law as an **Non-Condemnation Redevelopment Area**.
