A Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South River, in the County of Middlesex and the State of New Jersey was held March 14, 2011 and was called to order by Mayor Raymond T. Eppinger at 8:30 PM in the Council Chamber of the Criminal Justice Building at 61 Main Street in South River, New Jersey with the following Councilmembers in attendance:

Councilmembers Almeida, Guindi, Hutchison, Trzeciak, Vaughn and Krenzel

Also attending this meeting were Andrew J. Salerno, Borough Administrator and Gary M. Schwartz, Esq., Borough Attorney.

MINUTES

The Minutes of Meeting No. 4 held on February 14, 2011 were submitted to the Council for acceptance and/or amendment.

Councilman Krenzel moved that the Minutes be approved as presented. Councilman Hutchison seconded the motion. So carried.

ORDINANCES-SECOND READING & PUBLIC HEARING

ORD 2011-3

ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2011

WHEREAS, the Local Government CAP Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriation, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final

appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River in the County of Middlesex finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2011 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$384,173.06 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, County of Middlesex, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2011 budget year, the final appropriations of the Mayor and Borough Council shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$384,173.06, and that the CY 2011 municipal budget for the Borough of South River be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with the said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption, and publication according to law.

Mayor Eppinger asked the Chief Financial Officer to give a brief synopsis of the ordinance. Mr. Zanga stated that the ordinance gives the Borough flexibility to allow it to make certain decisions. As an example, the Mayor and Borough Council brought back the Construction Department in 2010. Funds were utilized from the Cap Bank.

Mayor Eppinger opened the hearing to the public for comments/questions.

Tele Koukoudelis, 93 James St.

- Thought that ordinance increases spending. Mr. Salerno responded that ordinance gives the borough flexibility for next year's budget.

John Scala, 440 Old Bridge Turnpike

- Commended Council for no tax increase.

Shawn Haussermann, 211 Willett Ave.

- Asked why this is done by ordinance. Mr. Zanga said that it is a state requirement. Mayor Eppinger noted it is a flexibility tool to help plan for the future. Mr. Salerno stated that CAP Banks have been around a long time.

No further comments were made. Councilman Hutchison moved that the public hearing be closed. Councilman Krenzel seconded the motion. So carried.

Mayor Eppinger asked if the Councilmembers have any comments.

Council Comments

Councilman Almeida

- Stated this sends wrong message to people; increased spending; will vote no.

Councilman Krenzel

- Don't know what future holds; increase allows us to bank money only for two years

Councilman Vaughn

- Ordinance gives us ability to spend.

Mayor Eppinger

- Only way to make substantial cuts is to lay off people; banking money from this year's budget for next year's budget.

Mayor Eppinger asked the Councilmembers as to the action to be taken on this Ordinance. Councilman Krenzel moved that the ordinance be approved and the Clerk be authorized to publish same as is required by law. Councilman Hutchison seconded the motion.

ORD 2011-4

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF
BLOCK 122 LOTS 1, 10 AND 10.01 FROM SOUTH
AMBOY ELKS LODGE 784 B.P.O.E., SUCCESSOR TO
SOUTH RIVER ELKS B.P.O.E. LODGE 2033

WHEREAS, the governing body previously determined that it is in the public interest to purchase premises owned by South Amboy B.P.O.E. Elks Lodge #784 successor to South River B.P.O.E. Elks Lodge #2033 and also known as Lots 1, 10 and 10.01 in Block 122 pursuant to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I.

The Mayor and Council find and determine that:

a) the premises known as Lots 1, 10 and 10.01 in Block 122 located at 205 Main Street in the Borough of South River are appropriately located for construction of a firehouse pursuant to both NFPA and Public Employees OSHA standards.

b) the acquisition of said premises will benefit the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of South River.

c) the acquisition of Lots 1, 10 and 10.01 in Block 122 from South Amboy BPOE Elks Lodge #784, successor to South River BPOE Elks Lodge #2033 is hereby authorized at a purchase price of \$950,000, said price consisting of a fair market value for said property, subject to the form, terms and conditions of a contract to be approved by the Borough Attorney.

SECTION II. The various parts, sections, clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION III. Any ordinances and parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication as may be required by law.

At the recommendation of the Borough Attorney, it was noted that Councilman Guindi would abstain from voting on this ordinance due to having a financial interest.

James Tyler Pituk, Advanta Appraisal Associates, was present to brief the Borough Council on the appraisal process for the Elks property. Mayor Eppinger noted that the appraisal was done subject to the standards of the industry.

Mayor Eppinger opened the hearing to the public for comments/questions. No comments were made. Councilman Krenzel moved that the public hearing be closed. Councilman Hutchison seconded the motion. So carried.

- Was not challenging appraisal; has problem spending \$950,000 for acre of property once building is razed.

Councilman Hutchison

- Subject has been on agenda for some time; has not seen general public come in.

Councilman Krenzel

- Had to follow process of getting appraisal.

Mayor Eppinger

- Process has been going on for long time.
- This is best place for firehouse.
- Has seen work of Building Committee.
- Public safety is most important.
- Wished we did not have to spend this much money, but we have to do it.
- Asked Council to support the ordinance.

ORD 2011-5

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER, CHAPTER 155 ENTITLED
“FEES” BY AMENDING SECTION 155-12.1 CHAPTER
147, ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS, ARTICLE III

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, that Chapter 155 of the Code of the Borough of South River entitled “Fees” be amended by amending a Section 155-12.1, Chapter 147, Electrical Connections, Article III as follows:

SECTION 1.

155-12.1. Chapter 147, Electrical Connections

[Fee for connection between municipal utility and self-generating electric equipment: \$5000] An escrow deposit of \$5,000 shall be paid to the South River Electric Utility for a connection between the municipal electric utility and self-generating electrical equipment. The escrow shall be utilized for an application fee of \$250.00, professional services of the Utility Engineer and Borough Attorney in reviewing plans submitted by an applicant as well as for preparation of an interconnection and purchase power and payment obligation agreements in addition to NETA testing costs, test result analysis by the Utility Engineer and meter programming fees. Inspection fees for such equipment and facility are set forth in Section 155-10 of the Borough Code. The escrow deposit shall be deposited by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough, or his/her designee, in an account for such purposes under the sole control of the Borough. Said escrow may be commingled with similar escrows from other applicants, but accurate accounts and records shall be kept so as to identify particular escrows and charges made against the same.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption, and publication according to law.

ORD 2011-6

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER, CHAPTER 289 ENTITLED "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS" BY DELETING SECTION 295-5B AND AMENDING SECTION 289-5A AND 289-6 THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, that Chapter 289 of the Code of the Borough of South River entitled "Streets and

Sidewalks” be amended by deleting Section 289-5B and amending Sections 289-5A and 289-6 as follows:

SECTION 1.

289-5

A. The owners, managers, agents and/or occupants of all premises and tenements within the Borough of South River shall, within 24 hours of the cessation of any fall of snow or formation of ice, remove all snow and ice from the sidewalks including handicapped access ramps and fire hydrants adjacent to said premises. Ice which is so frozen as to make removal impractical shall either be treated with rock salt or other chemicals which will thaw it sufficiently to permit removal or be thoroughly covered with sand, ashes or cinders.

B. [No summons shall be issued to the owner, manager, agent or occupant of any noncommercial premises for a violation of this section until 24 hours following service upon said owner, manager, agent or occupant of a written warning advising said owner, manager, agent or occupant of the requirements of this section. Service of said written warning shall be deemed complete upon the posting of said notice upon the premises, or by delivery of the same to an occupant of the premises other than an infant under 14 years of age or an incompetent person.]

289-6.

It shall be the duty of the police and Code Enforcement Officer to enforce the provisions of this article.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption, and publication according to law.
