PARKING AUTHORITY PRESENTATION

Bill Kahse, Secretary of the Parking Authority, discussed the matter of dissolving the Parking Authority and having its operation transferred to the Borough. Also present at the meeting were Skeeter Spitaleri, Kevin Appleby, Frank Jones, and Tom Roselli, Attorney for the Parking Authority.

Mr. Kahse outlined the current financial strains on the Authority and noted there would be a cost savings in having the Borough take over its operation.

Councilman Almeida asked if anything can be done to mitigate circumstances so the Parking Authority can remain independent. Mr. Kahse stated that state regulations are making it less cost-effective to continue as an independent authority.

Mayor Eppinger stated that a meeting was held with the Parking Authority to discuss this matter. Councilman Vaughn stated he received a lot of information relating to the Authority. If the Parking Authority wants the Borough to take it over, he will support it. Councilman Hutchison thanked the members of the Parking Authority for coming to this meeting and providing information.

Mr. Schwartz stated that the Parking Authority has to file a Certificate requesting termination of its existence with the Borough Clerk

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH
OF SOUTH RIVER, CHAPTER 287 ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE"
BY AMENDING SECTION 287-2E(4) THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, that Chapter 287 of the Code of the Borough of South River entitled "Solid Waste" be amended by amending Section 287-2E(4), as follows:

SECTION 1.

287-2E

(4) No person shall place at curbside any garbage container earlier than [at dusk] one hour before sunset the night before a scheduled collection, nor later than the normal hour of collection on the regularly scheduled day of such collection. No call-backs for a regularly scheduled collection shall be permitted.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption, and publication according to law.
