



It is our understanding the Borough would like to receive bids for the above referenced project. I have met with Mr. Thomas Noto, the Borough's Electric Utility Engineer, to review this matter. We recommend the Borough advertise for bids with Bid Document that solicits bids for the two options the Borough is considering. There would be a bid item for a single generator that would be able to operate the entire Public Works Facility and another set of bid items for the six (6) generators that would serve the facility. The bidders would be advised the Borough has the option to award a contract for the project to the lowest responsible bidder for either Bid Item-A or Bid Items-B. We would make it clear that it is possible for one contractor to be the low bidder for Bid Item-A and another for Bid Items-B. In order to expedite the project, the bid documents will be oriented toward a design/build contract where the contractor will be required to perform the soil borings, foundation design(s) and electrical design drawings for submission to the Borough Construction Office for permits. Mr. Noto will review the electrical drawings and we will review the geotechnical information and the structural design(s) for the foundation(s) in addition to the typical Construction Administration Services we each would normally perform.

We respectfully submit the following Professional Engineering Services cost estimates for the various Civil Engineering tasks of the above referenced project. Mr. Noto will submit a separate proposal for his professional Services.

- Design Phase Services \$16,740.00
- Bid Phase Services \$ 5,022.00

We will provide the Borough with a proposal for the Construction Administration once a decision is made on which option the Borough would like to award.


I have met with Bruce Koch of CME in order to come up with a plan to address the concerns that were raised in the Council Meeting on Monday. We agreed to recommend that the Borough proceed with a combination of design by our offices in combination with design build for some aspects of the project as explained in Bruce's proposal.

The electrical design drawings and specifications will include all generator sizing, primary and secondary conductor sizing, transfer schemes and layouts necessary to provide fully functional systems for both options i.e. the single site primary generator and the 6 individual building secondary generators. Review of all contractor submittals and design is included.

I respectfully submit the following Professional Engineering Services cost estimates for the Electrical Engineering tasks for the above referenced project. We anticipate that the design can be completed in 6 to 8 weeks.

**RE: Middlesex County Landfill
Adjoining Municipality Benefits Agreement**

Dear Mayor Krenzel:

The Middlesex County Utilities Authority (Authority) and the Borough of South River entered into an Adjoining Municipality Benefits Agreement nearly 10 years ago relating to the Authority's responsibility for the operation of the Middlesex County Landfill (MCLF). The current Agreement will expire December 31, 2013.

The Authority is proposing to continue providing benefits to the Borough of South River at the rate of \$1.50 per ton based on waste received for disposal at the MCLF. The Authority is proposing another 10 year Agreement beginning in 2014. A Form of Agreement has been prepared and is attached for your review. The terms of the proposed Agreement are the same as the present Agreement.

We ask that the attached Form of Agreement be considered for approval by the Borough of South River's Governing Body. Following approval, please return three original signed versions of the Agreement for execution by the Authority.

WHEREAS, the MCUA received a Solid Waste Facility permit under the Solid Waste Management Act on May 10, 1991, which permit has been renewed, to operate a sanitary landfill in East Brunswick ("Landfill") in order to operate a new landfill for Middlesex County residents; and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 1992, the MCUA acquired property located adjoining Edgeboro Road in East Brunswick, which property consists of a fee taking of approximately 99.3 acres, slope easements of 49.4 acres, multi-purpose easements of 19.6 acres and a utility easement of 1.4 acres at the Landfill; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-28.3, the MCUA is obligated to annually pay to certain municipalities located within close proximity to the Landfill certain sums ("Adjoining Municipality Benefits") in consideration of the adjoining community being located in close proximity to the Landfill; and

WHEREAS, based upon the agreements of the MCUA set forth herein, the Borough agrees not to undertake, participate in or initiate, in any manner whatsoever, any action at law or equity, any administrative proceedings or arbitration, the purpose of which is to challenge, block or impede the MCUA's use, operation and expansion of the Landfill (including the acquisition and use of adjoining property to be used in conjunction with the Landfill).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants undertaken and promises as set forth herein and the undertakings of the Borough and the MCUA, the parties, hereto, as by themselves, their successors and assigns, do mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. Adjoining Community Benefits:

Assuming the MCUA is operating the Landfill, MCUA agrees to pay to the Borough:

(a) A host community benefit for the years 2014 through 2023: \$1.50 per ton for all solid waste accepted for disposal in the Landfill for the year prior to the payment year (i.e., the payment due for year 2014 will be calculated by multiplying \$1.50 per ton by the total amount of solid waste tonnage provided for the year 2013).

(b) The above tonnage payments shall be based on solid waste as weighed and accepted for disposal, including any bulky waste weighed and accepted at the Landfill during each subsequent year. The parties hereto acknowledge that the Adjoining Community Benefits paid hereunder satisfy all obligations of the MCUA to pay an Adjoining Community Benefit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-28.3. The MCUA shall pay the above-noted benefits for the previous year on or before April 1st of each subsequent year of the Agreement. This benefit shall only be payable in any particular year if the MCUA is operating the Landfill.

2. Odor Control Equipment

(a) The MCUA agrees to comply with such requirements as the NJDEP requires in regulatory approvals and permits for operation of the Landfill.

(b) The MCUA agrees that while it is operating the Landfill, it will undertake to provide a twenty-four (24) hour telephone number for odor complaints.

(c) The MCUA will provide surveillance for the flares installed and will dispatch personnel to relight any unlit flares.

3. Operations of the Landfill.

(a) The MCUA agrees to employ a full-time, qualified supervisor to supervise the operations of the Landfill, including the placement of cover over the solid waste at the conclusion of each day's operation at the Landfill.

(b) In addition, the MCUA agrees to provide funding to the County of Middlesex for a full-time, licensed County Health Inspector at the Landfill to inspect the Landfill operations. Upon request by the Borough, the MCUA will forward to the Borough a copy of the Health Inspector's reports, which reports will include, but not be limited to, information on the adequacy of cover and the disposal of any prohibited materials.

(c) The parties agree that in the event of any reasonable concern on behalf of the Borough with regard to the operations of the Landfill, the Borough can directly contact the MCUA's on-site supervisor and/or the County Health Inspector assigned to the Landfill in order to have said officials address potential concerns.

4. Covenant Not to Sue: Limitation On Consultants.

(a) The Borough agrees not to undertake, participate in or initiate, in any manner whatsoever, any action at law or equity, any administrative proceeding or arbitration, the purpose of which is to challenge, block or impede the MCUA's use, operation and expansion of the landfilling facility at the Landfill site (including the acquisition and use of adjoining property to be used in conjunction with the Landfill). However, the Borough reserves the right to oppose a solid waste facility in East Brunswick other than the landfilling facility.

Consistent with the previous paragraph, the Borough will not provide financial support for any of its consultants or permit its own employees,

including any legal or technical advisors to appear or assist in any lawsuit, administrative hearing or arbitration, to request or give evidence or consultation on behalf of any objector or challenger to the MCUA's use, operation and expansion of a landfilling facility and related operations at the Landfill site.

(b) Nothing herein shall limit the use of the parties to seek to enforce the terms of this Agreement nor limit the right of individual representatives of the Borough to indicate their official position with the Borough and state their views in an individual capacity with regard to the MCUA's use, operation and expansion of the Landfill facility provided the South River governmental entity does not violate the terms of this Agreement.

5. Favored Nations Clause.

In the event legislation is enacted during the term of this Agreement that increases the Adjoining Community Benefit from the current maximum set forth in the statute, and in the further event that for any year covered by this Agreement, the MCUA determines to pay an Adjoining Community Benefit to either the Borough of Sayreville or the Township of Edison which is greater than the Adjoining Community Benefit payable to South River set forth in Paragraph 1 of this Agreement, the MCUA agrees that it will pay South River the incremental difference in order that it receive the same Adjoining Community Benefit that the MCUA has agreed to pay to either of the above-noted municipalities for the year in question.

6. Breach.

(a) In the event of an alleged breach, the Chief Executive Office of the non-breaching party shall notify the Chief Executive Officer of the alleged breaching party and they shall meet in an attempt to resolve the alleged breach. In the event the Chief Executive Officers cannot resolve the matter, the non-breaching party

will have the right to appear before the governing body of the alleged breaching party to present its position. In the further event that the matter is not resolved by the governing body, the non-breaching party may then file an action in a court of competent jurisdiction to enforce its rights.

(b) In the event either party breaches this Agreement and does not cure any default within fourteen (14) days of the date of the breach or in the event it is not practical to cure such breach within such fourteen (14) day period or shall fail to take reasonable action to cure such breach within said prescribed time, the non-breaching party may terminate this Agreement whereupon all obligations of the parties pursuant to this Agreement shall terminate.


