Mayor Krenzel (John),

I am writing to request that you use your office to ensure that residents of South River are given advance notice of mosquito spraying.

This past Monday evening, August 5, a truck from Middlesex County Mosquito Commission drove around the block spraying a dense fog of insecticide. I called the non-emergency number at the police station and the dispatcher said that they had been informed of the spraying only a half hour earlier by the Commission. She gave me their phone number and after some missed connections, I managed to speak to them yesterday to express my concerns. Bill Evegán from their office said that he had a conversation on Tuesday with our police chief and agreed to notify him directly before future sprays.

The chemical they use, as stated on the fact sheet on the Commission website, is an irritant. The fact sheet recommends that people and pets stay inside until the spray dissipates. Without advance notice, that action is not possible. My wife was sitting outside and came in coughing. My cat was outside but suffered no apparent effects.

Yesterday, I called the Town Clerk. I spoke to a Debbie Jones (please instruct your staff to identify themselves readily when they answer the phone) and she was of little help, saying that "we don't get enough notice to let the residents know". The Commission said that they will now provide at least one day's notice. If so, I suggest that the town utilize the telephone notification system that is in place for this purpose. The system is in place, so there would be no cost, only a

bit of effort to record the message and activate the calls.

As you are aware, the NJDOT has awarded the Borough a Trust Fund Grant in the amount of \$310,000.00 for the above referenced project. Our preliminary construction cost estimate for same, when the grant was submitted, was \$399,070.00. The cost estimate included the reconstruction of Kamm Avenue from Oak Street to Whitehead Avenue. The estimate also included the replacement of existing and/or the installation of new ADA accessible curb ramps within the project limits.

Since the Borough has received less money than requested from the NJDOT, the project limits may need to be reduced to match the grant. The Borough may also want to consider utilizing HCD funds for the reconstruction of ADA curb ramps.

We would like to point out that Milton Court lies on the southerly side of this section of Kamm Avenue. As with the previous section, the Borough may want to consider repaving that road as part of this project.

Hello Fred, I have the following comments regarding this contract:

- 1) Is the list of Parks to be serviced complete?;
- 2) We must notify them when the service begins and ends. At \$365 per week the "end" is important. I assume that this is seasonal, but you better make sure that notice is properly and promptly given when it is no longer necessary;
- 3) The contract is open ended as to the expiration date, which does not comply with State law. It should not exceed three years;
- 4) "Geese Police recommends that all its clients register for **Resident Canada Goose Nest Egg Registration** to obtain federal authorization for treating Canada goose nests and eggs on your property." Are we prepared to do that? Apparently there are some significant penalties if we fail to do so. Also there is an additional weekly fee of \$100 per nest if they kill the eggs. Are we ok with that? Seems like the bill could really get out of hand;
- 5) "If another company or your employees handles eggs or nests, Geese Police will assess a penalty of \$1,000 per occurrence." That's absurd!; and
- 6) Are we prepared to pay interest if we don't pay their bill within 30 days?



Thank you for your interest in the services of Geese Police, Inc. Please sign the proposals and fax or mail one copy to us. Upon receipt of signed proposal, we will be able to begin services at your request.

Geese Police, Inc. will provide environmentally safe Canada goose control with use of working border collies. Geese Police, Inc. will visit your site several times a day during the initial two weeks of service. Geese Police, Inc. will subsequently visit your site at least once a day or more as deemed necessary by Geese Police, Inc. during any additional week of service. Geese Police, Inc. visits to the site will occur at different periods of the day for seven (7) days a week.

FEES FOR SERVICE: Geese Police, Inc. charges the following fees for the service:

This procedure requires a "no-feeding" policy to be in effect at all times. The client will be responsible for registering with the US Fish & Wildlife Service.
