A Special Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South River, in the County of Middlesex and the State of New Jersey was held August 18, 2014 and was called to order by Mayor Krenzel at 7:00 PM in the Council Chamber of the Criminal Justice Building at 61 Main Street in South River, New Jersey with the following Councilmembers in attendance:

Councilman Haussermann was absent.

Also attending this meeting was Frederick Carr, Borough Administrator.

Future of Firehouse and Firehouse Discussion

Mayor Krenzel stated that the purpose of the meeting has changed since during the Council meeting of August 11, 2014, the consensus of Council was to go out to bid for the design of the firehouse.

Councilman Hutchison commented on the figures Mitchell Associates Architects received on the Monroe firehouse. Mr. Londensky commented that South River would not have the same issues as Monroe. Utilization of the Boxing Club was discussed. Councilman Roselli said there was talk of Boxing Club being used as a warming station and he has concerns about that. Mr. Londensky advised that right now 55 Reid St. would be used for warming station. Mayor Krenzel noted that Mr. Carr and Mr. Londensky are discussing plans for a warming station in the north and south of town.

Mayor Krenzel stated that the future of the Fire Department has to be reviewed. There are three companies now. He recommended Council authorize Public Safety to discuss with Fire Department and report back to Council.
