Chapter 22. Boards, Commissions and Authorities

Article X. Cable Television Advisory Board

§ 22-48. Purpose.

The purpose of the Board shall be to assist the governing body in making its determination in the award of cable television franchise and to monitor the performance during the term of the franchise of the cable television company that is awarded said franchise and to receive, investigate, report and follow any complaints with respect to the service provided by the cable franchise serving the Borough of South River.

§ 22-49. Creation; membership; terms.

- A. There is hereby created in and for the Borough of South River a Cable Television Advisory Board, which shall consist of seven members, who shall reside within the Borough of South River. The members of the Board shall serve without compensation. The Board shall annually, upon reorganization, elect a Chairman from its members. No resident shall be permitted to serve on that Board if that member owns, controls or acquires any direct or indirect interest in a CATV company, which has applied for or received a municipal consent from the Borough pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.
- B. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Borough Council. Each member of the Board shall serve for a three-year term, except that, in its initial term, the Mayor shall appoint two members to serve a one-year term; two members to serve a two-year term; and three members to serve a three-year term.

§ 22-50. Goals.

The Cable Television Advisory Board shall be established for the following:

- A. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall act as a cable television complaint board (complaint officer) with respect to the Borough's cable television franchise.
- B. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall act as a government liaison between the cable television franchisee and the citizens of the Borough of South River.
- C. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall make suggestions to and aid TV 35 personnel in developing and coordinating a local access program system for the Borough of South River. [Amended 2-12-1997 by Ord. No. 1997-2]
- D. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall act as an advisory committee for the franchising or refranchising of the CATV system within the Borough of South River.

- E. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall act as a liaison between the cable television franchisee, the governing body and the citizens of the Borough of South River. In this capacity, the Cable Television Advisory Board may make recommendations to the governing body or the franchisee for the improvement of service by the CATV system.

§ 22-51. Local access programming.

[Amended 2-12-1997 by Ord. No. 1997-2]

The Cable Television Advisory Board shall also be responsible for aiding and making suggestions to TV 35 personnel with respect to local access programming within the Borough of South River. The Cable Television Advisory Board shall be authorized to work with the citizens and Board of Education, as well as other areas of local government and citizen groups, to help aid in the development and maintenance of such a system. The Board shall be authorized to hear from interested persons wishing to utilize the local access channel for education, culture or entertainment programming. The Board shall exercise no editorial discretion, except to ensure that all state and federal regulations are complied with.

§ 22-52. Refranchising; evaluation of franchisee; report.

- A. Pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission (47 CFR 76.5 et seq.), the Cable Communication's Policy Act (47 U.S.C. § 546 et seq.), as well as the Cable Television Act (N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.), and their amendments and/or supplements, the Mayor and Borough Council authorized the Cable Television Advisory Board to ascertain past, present and future needs of the Borough with regard to the CATV system. The Board shall be authorized to evaluate past and present performance of the present franchisee and shall further be authorized to evaluate the franchisee's proposal for addressing future needs of the Borough. The Board is authorized to hold one or more public hearings as it deems necessary commencing at least three years prior to the expiration of any franchise term, for the purpose of determining the past, present and future needs of the Borough, as well as determining the past and present performance of the franchisee.
- B. Upon determining the past, present and future needs of the Borough of South River, as well as determining the past and present performance of the franchisee, the Board shall issue a report to the governing body and the franchisee with regard to its findings. The franchisee shall then be given the opportunity to come before the Cable Television Advisory Board with a proposal for addressing the present and future needs within the Borough.
- C. During the refranchising or franchising process before the Board of Public Utilities, Office of Cable Television or any such successor as authorized by the State of New Jersey, the Cable Television Advisory Board shall be expressly authorized to appear and provide testimony with regard to its findings. In addition to any hearing before the Office of Cable Television with regard to matters regarding cable television, franchising or refranchising, the Cable Television Advisory Board shall expressly be authorized to make reports and offer testimony to the governing body at any public hearing held concerning an application for franchising or refranchising of a CATV system in the Borough of South River.

§ 22-53. Municipal complaint officer.

The South River Borough Cable Television Advisory Board is hereby designated as the complaint officer for the Borough of South River pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq. All complaints shall be received and processed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 14:17-7.1.

Fred,

Attached please find a revised ordinance based upon my discussion with Ms. Nevin.

Originally, Ms. Nevin indicated that you and the Chief wanted to keep the current ordinance/code exactly as is with the addition of the section in the taxi cab ordinance. If that is your request, I can absolutely draft the ordinance in that fashion. However, as I explained to Ms. Nevin, I would advise against it for clarity, proper formatting and some issues identified below.

Particularly, in the drafted ordinance Section 363-3, the requirement for the applicants to obtain a background check is a separate section since it is an additional requirement. The criminal background check would not be initially included in the suggested form as referenced in Section A. After I spoke with Ms. Nevin about this particular section, she indicated she agreed it should remain as drafted. If you would still like me to make this change, please advise.

After our original conversation, you and the Chief indicated that you did not want a driver's abstract to be submitted with the background check. Ms. Nevin indicated you have changed your mind and would like a

driver's abstract to be obtained. Therefore, I revised the ordinance to provide a driver's abstract for all operators of motor vehicles.

Additionally, according to Ms. Nevin, instead of amending 363-17, you wanted me to create another section. I indicated that I can absolutely do that; however, since we already have a section concerning Investigations it would be appropriate to include the criminal background check in that section. Again, Ms. Nevin indicated she agreed with the above. If you would still like me to make this change, please advise accordingly.

Furthermore, Ms. Nevin indicated you wanted me to include the Chief of Police in the following list:

§ 363-17. INVESTIGATIONS AND INSPECTIONS.

- A. Upon receipt of an application for a license or permit, the Borough Clerk shall refer such application to the following departments for the purpose of making an investigation or inspection, and said departments shall make a report thereon, favorably or otherwise, within seven business days after receiving the application or a copy thereof:
1. Health Department (with respect to such licenses in connection with the care and handling of food and the prevention of nuisances and spread of disease and the requirements of this article).
 2. Zoning Officer (to determine solely whether the proposed business conforms to the zone in which the property is located and the requirements of this article).
 3. Fire Prevention Department (to determine whether or not the vehicle to be utilized under the requirements of this article complies with the fire safety codes and the requirements of this article).

I advised Ms. Nevin that since this section requires the Department to provide its report within seven days after receiving the application, if the Chief does not receive the background within 7 days, the provision would be violated. Therefore, I removed the Chief of Police and created an entirely new section. The new section indicates that the application with the Criminal background check shall be forwarded to the Chief upon receipt. The Section reads:

§ 363-17(B) (NOW B WAS C IN PREVIOUS ORDINANCE)

"Upon receipt of the criminal background check and driver's abstract, the Borough Clerk shall forward the complete application, including the background investigation, to be reviewed by the Chief of Police who shall cause such investigation of the criminal background and business and moral character to be made as they deem necessary for the protection of the public good. Said investigation, prior to the issuance of a license hereunder, shall be mandatory. If the result of said investigation is that the application is satisfactory, same shall be approved by the Chief of Police. If as a result of such investigation the applicant's background reveals a prior history involving crimes of moral turpitude within the past 10 years or if the operator's driving records, character or business responsibility is found to be unsatisfactory, the application may be recommended to be denied. If the applications is recommended to be denied, the reasons for said denial must indicated in writing by the Chief."

Ms. Nevin advised to move Section B (same in the code and the drafted ordinance) which states that "In the event any department indicates some unfavorable comment that department shall set forth specifically the facts for such comment in writing" to Section C. In the revised ordinances attached, I made this revision.

Concerning the Section C (newly B), on the phone, after some discussion, you indicated that I should leave the specific crimes out of the ordinance since it would allow for more discretion from the Chief. Finally, you indicated that you wanted me to try to soften the requirement a bit. Therefore, I also I changed the word - shall to may. Therefore, the Chief of Police has the discretion to recommend the disqualification based upon the background check.

Again, the current 363-17(b) provides "In the event that any department's investigation or inspection indicates some unfavorable comment, that department shall set forth specifically the facts for such comment in writing." Therefore, I provided in the section for the Chief to provide unfavorable comments in writing as it is consistent with the rest of the process for this license. I was not directed to change this aspect of the ordinance. If, however, you want the Chief to have the ability to deny the application, additional changes to the current ordinance would be required. If this is your desire, please advise.

Unfortunately, the taxi cab ordinance section you are referring to does not fit with the Mobile food establishment process. If we were to implant the entire section, we would have to revise additional sections of your code. However, again, if you would like me to revise the ordinance to solely include the language from the taxi cab ordinance, please advise.

On conclusion Ms. Nevin instructed me to keep Section 363-13 as is but to include the requirement for a driver's abstract in Section 363-13 (B) for all motor vehicles. She further instructed me to add in the Chief of Police in the 363-17 list of departments that have 7 days from the receipt of the application to give its report. She also instructed me to move my Section B to Section C. Finally, she indicated I should keep the newly drafted section B but to add in the driver's abstract issue.

All of Ms. Nevin's requested revisions are incorporated within the revised ordinance. Please be advised I still advise against including the Chief of Police in 363-17(A) as it places a time limit on his review. Notwithstanding the foregoing, I have revised the ordinance to include the change. Please advise if any additional revision are necessary.
