- (2) If the applicant shall be a professional requiring licensing in the State of New Jersey; said applicant shall be licensed for a period of not less than five (5) years;
- (3) The applicant shall submit a “Certificate in Good Standing”, an Affidavit or other similar document evidencing and confirming that the professional’s license is not presently suspended or revoked;

(4) The applicant shall submit a resume, which shall set forth information including, but not limited to the following (as applicable to a business entity or individual professional):

Additional Requirements
