AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER, CHAPTER 193 ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” BY AMENDING SECTION 193-31.1, SCHEDULE IIA “HANDICAPPED PARKING” THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, that Chapter 193 of the Code of the Borough of South River entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" be amended by amending Section 193-31.1, Schedule IIA as follows:

SECTION 1. Schedule IIA. HANDICAPPED PARKING

Street	Side	Location
James St.	West	57 Feet North of Johnson Place

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption, and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VARIOUS FEDERAL HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANT IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT LOCATED IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River in the County of Middlesex of the State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant of the applicable statutes of the State of New Jersey, there is hereby authorized:

- i. Handicap Access Improvements - curb cuts, appropriating \$37,101.00; and

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE PLANNING BOARD TO UNDERTAKE AN INVESTIGATION OF THE MAIN STREET REHABILITATION DISTRICT AS A POSSIBLE AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT, PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 authorizes the governing body, by resolution, to authorize the Planning Board to undertake an investigation to determine whether an area within the Borough of South River is in need of redevelopment in which the municipality may use powers provided by the Legislature for use in a redevelopment area other than the use of eminent domain or

condemnation according to criteria set forth in *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5*; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body to authorize the Planning Board to undertake such an investigation to determine whether the Main Street Rehabilitation District of the Borough of South River, satisfies the criteria to be designated as an area in need of redevelopment pursuant to the aforementioned law; and

WHEREAS, before proceeding to a public hearing on the matter in accordance with the requirements of state statute, the Planning Board shall prepare and submit to the governing body a map showing the boundaries of the proposed redevelopment area and the location of the various parcels of property included therein as identified by this Resolution, together with a statement setting forth the basis for the investigation; and

WHEREAS, any interested or affected property owners shall be duly notified of the date of a hearing for the purpose of being heard in regard to the determination of the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, all hearing notice requirements shall be followed in accordance with the requirements of *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6*; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of South River, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. WHEREAS, a traffic study report indicated that the intersection of Main Street, Ferry Street and Reid streets operated at a failed level of service during PM Peak hour traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Middlesex County Engineering Department engaged the engineering firm of Hatch Mott MacDonald to draft a Concept Study implementing improvements to the intersection to increase the levels of service; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council passed Resolution 2010-357 in November of 2010 selecting proposed intersection improvements and authorizing the initial design phase of same; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council wishes to further discuss the proposed design changes with the County Engineering Office and has asked the Borough Administrator to contact the County Engineer to request a meeting between the Borough and the County for this purpose.
