ORDINANCES – SECOND READING & PUBLIC HEARING

ORD 2016-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 22, ENTITLED “BOARDS COMMISSIONS AND AUTHORITIES” SO AS TO AMEND ARTICLE V

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River,  
County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 22 of the Borough Code of the Borough of South River, entitled "Boards, Commissions and Authorities" is hereby amended so to delete Article V Municipal Cultural Arts and Heritage Commission, Section 22-21 in its entirety and replace it with the following:

Article V. Municipal Cultural Arts and Heritage Commission

§ 22-21. Creation; Regular membership.

There is hereby created a Municipal Cultural Arts and Heritage Commission consisting of nine regular members. At least two regular members shall be from among the following arts and professions: painting, sculpture, music, literature, landscape and landscape architecture. At least one regular member shall be learned in the historic or architectural traditions of the Borough of South River. All members shall serve without compensation. The members of the Commission who are first appointed shall be designated to serve for terms of one, two, three, four and five years, respectively, from the date of their appointments, but thereafter, members shall be appointed for a term of five years, except that all vacancies shall be filled for the duration of the unexpired term only. The term of office of members of the Commission shall commence on January 1 of each year. Appointments shall be made by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Borough Council. All members shall be citizens and residents of the Borough of South River.

SECTION 2. Chapter 22 of the Borough Code of the Borough of South River, entitled "Boards, Commissions and Authorities" is hereby amended so as to include, Section 22-21.1 Alternate Members:

§ 22-21.1 Alternate Members.

A. Alternate members shall be designated, at the time of appointment, as "Alternate No. 1" and "Alternate No. 2." The terms of the alternate members shall be five years. A vacancy occurring otherwise than by the expiration of a term shall be filled by the appointment of the Mayor for the unexpired term only.

B. Alternate members may participate in discussions of the proceedings but may not vote except in the absence or disqualification of a regular member. No vote shall be delayed in order that a regular member may vote instead of an alternate member. In the event that a choice must be made as to which alternate member is to vote, Alternate No. 1 shall vote first.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 22 of the Borough Code of the Borough of South River, entitled "Boards, Commissions and Authorities" is hereby amended so as to include Article IV Environmental Commission/Shade Tree Advisory Board, Section 22-13.1, Advisory Consultants:

Article IV. Environmental Commission/Shade Tree Advisory Board

§ 22-13.1 Advisory Consultants.

In addition to the Regular Members and Alternate Members of the Environmental Commission/Shade Tree Advisory Board, the Mayor shall appoint two Advisory Consultants. Advisory Consultants may participate in discussions of the proceedings but may not vote. Advisory Consultants shall serve without compensation. There is no residency requirement for the Advisory Consultants.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Borough of South River provides health insurance benefits to certain employees through the New Jersey State Health Benefits Plan (“SHBP”); and

WHEREAS, the Borough also provides retiree health insurance to certain eligible and qualified employees in accordance with Public Law 1974, Ch. 88; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that it is in the Borough's and its employees' best interests to leave the SHBP and join the Central Jersey Health Insurance Fund ("HIF") for the provision of health insurance, including retiree health benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough will leave the SHBP and enter the HIF effective April 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Borough Administration has recommended that current employees continue to be eligible for Borough-provided retiree health benefits under the requirements of Public Law 1974, Ch. 88 consistent with Borough Resolution #1994-421; and

WHEREAS, Borough Administration has recommended that future employees have a minimum of 25 years of service with the Borough, or retire on a disability pension, to qualify for Borough-provided retiree health benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has considered the recommendation of Borough Administration and deems it in the best interests of the Borough, the public, and its employees that the Borough retain the eligibility requirements for retiree health benefits for current employees consistent with Public Law 1974, Ch. 88.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South River hereby establish the following policy:

Any employee hired prior to April 1, 2016 and who is otherwise eligible for Borough-provided retiree health benefits shall receive retiree health benefits so long as the employee retires from a State-administered pension system with a minimum of 25 years of service in the pension system, or as otherwise consistent with the Borough's adoption of P.L. 1974, Ch. 88 per Resolution # 1994-421.

Employees hired on or after April 1, 2016, who are otherwise eligible for Borough-provided retiree health benefits, who retire on a disability pension, or have a minimum of 25 years of service in the Borough with a minimum of 25 years of service in the pension system, shall qualify for Borough-provided retiree health benefits. This eligibility of Borough-provided retiree health benefits does not alter an employee's obligation to contribute to retiree health benefits as may be required by Borough policy, collective negotiations agreement, or State law.

This resolution is effective April 1, 2016.
