MINUTES

REPORTS

The monthly registrar report for March 2010 was reviewed, read and a motion to accept the report was made by Joan Pisuk. Seconded by Doreen Hamelin. All were in favor. The monthly health inspector's sanitation report for March 2010 was reviewed, read and a motion to accept the report was made by Doreen Hamelin. Seconded by Ruth Byczkowski. All were in favor. Dog and Cat Reports for March 2010 were reviewed and filed.

OLD BUSINESS

2. Animal Control – TNR Account as of 4-19-2010, \$586.61.

Paul Zelanko stated that he attended the last Feral Cat Committee and wanted to reinforce to them what the Town needs them to do (Ex.: Educate and Fund Raise) and Whiskers Rescue was to do the trapping. Since that time the action of the Committee seemed to be not in the best interest of the Borough. (Ex.: Borough has plenty of money don't worry about the cats, Borough will take care of them, Committee having the Police called out on them) Therefore, as of this date, the Committee is suspended

until Paul continues to fact-find until the next meeting. At that time, one of three things can happen. Reappoint with all members, reform with smaller committee and Town's needs or abolish Committee and appoint Whiskers Rescue.

3. Food Bank – account as of 4-19-2010, \$10,135.82. Holy Trinity continues opening on the 1st Saturday of each month. Post Office Drive 5/8/2010. John Bouthillette stated that the Food Bank was opened during the March 13-14 storm and helped about 35 families giving them snacks until the Red Cross came and took over.

Atlantic City trip going well we still have a few more seats left. Fish Fry moving along, Board will teaming up with Project Graduation to help with the event and will share in half of the proceeds.
