Paul Zelanko stated that Kris Kadela sent in a letter of resignation. Paul will forward to Mayor and hope to have someone appointed soon.

MINUTES

Monthly minutes for March 2011 were submitted for approval and/or amendment. Michael Trenga made a motion to approve the minutes. Seconded by Shirley Peteet. All were in favor.

REPORTS

The monthly health inspector's sanitation report for March 2011 were read and reviewed. Shirley Peteet made a motion to accept reports. Seconded by Shari Mammano. All were in favor.

Dog and Cat Report for March 2011 was reviewed and filed.

OLD BUSINESS

- Food Bank – account as of 4-14-2011, \$12,326.81. Borough is the process of getting a freezer donated to them by East Brunswick. Shari still working on Shop-Rite to donated outdated cans of food. Post Office Drive 5-14-2011, all members are urged to participate. 5-14-11 National Honor Society is holding a flea market. Money collected to rent a table will be turned into food and brought to food bank by NHS Students. Extra giveaway for April, turkey and ham.
- Animal Control – Darren Doran, Animal Control Officer attended meeting to give a summary of 2010. 37 Dogs, 125 Cats (Helmetta, Sayrebrook and Bluming), and 109 Wildlife (raccoons, skunks, ground hogs and possums). May 1, 2011 shelter expected to open in Helmetta, South River to sign agreement shortly.
- Food Bank Synergy – Crop Walk collected \$4,943.00, 56 people participated. 25% of the profit made went to the Union Baptist Church. Non-perishable foods 30-40 bags went to the South River Food Bank.
- Event Planning – Account as of 4/14/2011, \$196.42. National Night Out 8/2. Board will be participating with the help of KEPA to put on a Dog Show. Frost on the Pumpkin sponsored by the Board 10/30. Account currently has \$1,800.00, Health and Wellness Fair, 10/2, Paul to secure the KOC for the location and ACS Relay for Life, 5/21, Board has decided not to participate this year. Board Members will be needed to participate in all up-coming events.
- County Health – Core Functions of public Health, Joan to give update at next meeting.
- Handicap and Disabled – Teresa to report any updates at next meeting.
- Operation RAM – Account as of 4/14/2011 \$1,237.24. 12 boxes were sent out to 4 soldiers who received 3 boxes each. Boxes were received and very much appreciated. Soldiers especially enjoy receiving cards for elementary students; they hang them up in their barracks and each day before leaving for the field gives the cards a touch.
- Fund Raising – Debbie stated that she will be working on the 2011 Food Bank Mailing. Discussion of a possible AC trip in September to benefit Operation RAM.
