##### ORD 2009-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF HANDICAPPED RAMPS AT VARIOUS INTERSECTIONS WITH WHITEHEAD AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$24,100.00 THEREFORE

Section 1. That pursuant of the applicable statutes of the State of New Jersey, there is hereby authorized the purchase and installation of depressed curbs and ADA compliant handicap ramps with detectable warning surfaces at various intersections with Whitehead Avenue.

Section 2. That the sum of twenty-four thousand one hundred dollars and no cents (\$24,100.00) and the same is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 therefore and that the prior Capital Budget is hereby amended to provide for said appropriation.

Section 3. That there is presently available Federal Housing and Community Development Act funds in the amount of twenty-four thousand one hundred dollars and no cents (\$24,100.00), which sum is hereby appropriated for the purpose described in Section 1 thereof.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF  
SOUTH RIVER, CHAPTER 147 ENTITLED "ELECTRICAL  
CONNECTIONS" BY ADDING A NEW ARTICLE V, SECTION 40,  
"IDENTITY THEFT POLICY"

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to implement an identity theft program and policy within the borough.

WHEREAS, The Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003, an amendment to the Fair Credit Reporting Act, required rules regarding identity theft protection to be promulgated by certain governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, those rules became effective May 1, 2009, and require the South River Electric Utility to implement an identity theft program and policy since it extends credit by billing consumers for utility services after such services are received, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of South River in the County of Middlesex has determined that an Identity Theft Policy is in the best interest of the South River Electric Utility and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, that Chapter 147 of the Code of the Borough of South River entitled "Electrical Connections" be amended by adding a new Article V, Section 40, as follows:

SECTION 1.

ARTICLE V

147-40

A certain policy to be known as the "Identity Theft Policy of the South River Electric Utility" as required by the Fair and Accurate Transactions Act of 2003, as amended, is hereby adopted for the regulation of employees, contractors, consultants, temporary workers and any other workers of the South River Electric Utility, including all personnel affiliated with third parties; each and all of the provisions, conditions and terms of said policy are hereby adopted and made a part hereof as fully set out in a copy of the policy manual on file with the Borough Clerk and the Collector of Utility Revenue.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption, and publication according to law.
