Eligibility Guidelines

The services of the South River Food Bank are intended for **South River residents** who are in need of assistance to help close the gap in their monthly food budget. Our current Eligibility guidelines recommend maximum monthly INCOME and RESOURCES at or below 200% of the Federal poverty level. (See the chart below.) **It is not our intention to restrict services for South River residents who are truly in need. We recognize that there are many additional factors that may affect your particular needs at this time. You will have the opportunity to provide this information when registering at the food bank.**

RESOURCES OCTOBER 2015 200 Percent of Federal Guidelines
Households may have \$4,500 in countable resources such as a bank account or \$6,500 if at least one person is age 60 or older or is disabled.

Additionally:

- A valid ID and current proof of South River residence are required at each visit.
- The food bank services are limited to ONE VISIT PER HOUSEHOLD PER MONTH. (Please be advised that a single family home is considered one household no matter how many adults are living or renting rooms within the home.)
