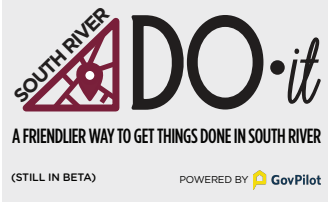
A Vision For Downtown
