## Vacant Properties

The Borough Council has introduced a “Vacant Properties” Ordinance, mimicking language in neighboring towns in an attempt to reduce vacancies and address neglected properties around the borough. As proposed, if a property is currently unoccupied, abandoned, and unable to be occupied without repair, or is not being actively marketed, such properties will be required to register as a vacant property. Moneys collected are proposed to be placed in a “South River Beautification Fund” to remedy neglected property issues.
